

Privacy Policy

InterLutions is committed to maintaining the privacy of our members. We maintain any information you provide over the Internet according to our usual strict security and confidentiality standards. The information practices of our website are set forth below.

InterLutions does not collect, store, or use information obtained through this website, except as described below. In general, you can visit us on the World Wide Web without disclosing to us who you are or revealing any information about yourself. When visiting our website, InterLutions may collect and store information on:

- Domain names
- Dates and times of website visits
- Pages that you visit
- If you linked to this website from another website, the address of that website
- The IP (Internet Protocol) address (an IP address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer whenever you are surfing the Web) from which you access our website
- The action that you tried to perform (for example, download a document) and whether you were successful

This information allows us to track use, measure website traffic and improve website navigation and information. InterLutions may use the IP address information to monitor unusually heavy activity from a single address.

InterLutions may use feedback from members and non-members to respond to inquiries, comments or suggestions. If you choose to give us feedback on this website via electronic mail, or you request additional information, you will be asked for your name and address and will have the option of providing other information. If you send email to InterLutions, we will consider that to be your consent for InterLutions to use the information collected from the message consistent with this policy. This information is not sold, given, or disclosed to third parties.

If you provide your name and other information, InterLutions will maintain the information to process your request or inquiry. InterLutions employees will see the information in the course of their official duties. In limited circumstances, such as court order or as required by law, we may disclose information you submit. Although questions, comments, and other communications that are received generally are not retained as permanent records, please note that it is possible that any mail - electronic or paper - that we receive could become part of the permanent record of InterLutions.

Please note that email is not necessarily secure against interception and that email features in this website are not encrypted. If your communication is sensitive, you might want to send it by postal mail instead of email, or visit our secure website at the member access website location.

On our member access website location, we use a secured socket layer, using a minimum of 128-bit encryption and firewall protection. This means that each time you logon to our member access website; you will be required to provide your username and password. For security of our website and to ensure that the website remains available to all users, InterLutions employs software programs to monitor network traffic and to identify unauthorized attempts to upload or change information or cause damage.
